# INAUGURAL GAYTABLOS ART SHOW

### EXHIBITION THEME-ALAC MISSION:

Proposals for the current exhibition are now being accepted: Artists working at all levels of their career are invited to submit work for consideration. ALAC is open to the general public and provides artists with an exceptional opportunity for exposure. ALAC is committed to creating a legacy of Latino arts and culture. Artists are encouraged to submit 1 to 6 pieces of their own artwork.

It is a deeply spiritual process to be able to see the images which live beneath the surface of a blank canvas or a stack of raw materials. This is the gift of being an artist. The painful irony of being 2SLGBTQ+ is that, while we are expected to be artistic, we are subject to routine expulsion from spiritual spaces by the cishet gatekeepers of the Abrahamic religions. They command us to project divinity outward without allowing us access the divinity within.

Endemic to many of the pre-Columbian societies in the Americas was an understanding of, and tolerance for, sexual and gender diversity, which the Church, with cruel efficiency, nearly – but not quite – stamped out. What was common to many ancient ways of seeing the world was a strong faith in certain basic characteristics believed to define those who diverged from the sexual and gender binary. When our perception of the world was intuitive, the divinity living beneath the surface of our canvas was inherent. This knowledge was among the first indigenous beliefs determined to be heretical.

In the Theme of Retablo Art, **Gaytablos** calls for the submission of original two- and three-dimensional works reflective of the artist's understanding of, and gratitude for, their 2SLGBTQ+ identity and inherent divinity for a juried exhibit hosted by the Arizona Latino Arts and Cultural Center (ALAC), please visit [www.gaytablos.org](http://www.gaytablos.org).

### ELIGIBILITY:

Artists 18 years or older may submit work for consideration. Submissions must be original works of art completed by the artist within the last three years. Artists may submit work in any media; however, 3D artists will be asked to provide pedestals or other display materials required for their artwork or for art work that requires special installation. Artists selected for exhibition will be responsible for delivery and retrieval of their artwork.

August 15 at noon: Entry Deadline

August 21st by 5pm: Notifications Emailed (*you will receive an email for each image submitted*)

September 25-27th, 10am-5pm: Artwork Drop Off

October 1st, 5-8pm: Exhibition Opening Day

October 15, 4:30pm: Awards Presentation (virtual)

December 28<sup>th</sup> – January 5<sup>th</sup> : 12pm – 4:30pm: Pick up Artwork. Artwork not picked within this time period will incur a storage fee of \$30 per day. After 30 days, artwork not picked up becomes property of ALAC.

## **ARTWORK FRAMING:**

The artist's artwork should be professionally framed. If the framed artwork is deemed inadequately framed, the artist will incur ALAC framing costs to ensure the artwork is exhibition ready. For those needing help, ALAC provides reasonable framing services.

## **EXHIBITION FEE:**

The regular exhibition fee is \$25. Your \$25 also go towards your \$25 artist membership fee.

## **SALES:**

Sale of artwork is required to be considered for exhibition. All transactions will be handled by ALAC; and ALAC applies a 40% commission fee to all work sold. **Initials**\_\_\_\_\_

## **HOW TO APPLY:**

Please complete the online submission packet and return it by **August 15, 2021** with the following:

1. A brief bio (no more than one page in length) with a picture of the artist.
2. Images of work to be considered for the exhibit must be electronic images.
3. Images must match the titles as they appear on the submission form.

All work submitted may not be exhibited but should represent the artist's current style and ability. Artists may also be asked to create new work for exhibition. ALAC reserves the right to reject artwork that varies significantly from submitted images, is aesthetically challenged, or that deviates from the

**SELECTION PROCESS:**

Submissions will be juried by the ALAC Artists and Curators Elizabeth Toledo, Jose Andres Girón, Román Reyes and Jeffery Lazos Ferns. Selections will be made based on aesthetic quality, artistic merit, technical ability and appropriateness for exhibition theme-ALAC's mission.
